How do I borrow books?

1. Contact the library by telephone or e-mail.

3. Tell us which book you wish to borrow, or if you want us to pick out some books for you.

How do I get my books?

The library will inform you when your books are ready to be collected. You can collect your books at the school's main entrance Monday-Thursday: 08:00-15:00

If you need to copy a few pages from reference literature or course books, we will help you. You can copy a maximum of 15 pages at any time according to the Copyright Act.
